

Vienna Theatre Project presents another outstanding, award-winning comedy. The play is set in 2008 and follows four Iranians who meet three times a week for an English test preparation course (TOEFL) in Karaj, Iran. The course is led by Marjan, who forbids speaking Farsi in class. The students translate Ricky Martin songs and struggle with prepositions while discovering how to be funny in English. As the class gradually descends into linguistic chaos, some students cling to their native language, while others embrace the opportunities a new language offers. This quietly powerful play shows how learning a foreign language can reflect deeper struggles, change identities, and open doors to new lives.

A humorous and moving play that tells the story of how the author became the founder of a homemade face mask operation during the first months of the COVID pandemic. On the third day of the COVID-19 pandemic, Kristina Wong, a member of NYTW Usual Suspects, began sewing masks from old bed sheets and bra straps on her Hello Kitty sewing machine. Soon, she led the Auntie Sewing Squad, a home-based sweatshop group of hundreds of volunteers – including children and her own mother – to repair the public health system in the U.S. during quarantine. It was a feminist care utopia formed amid the crisis. Or was it a mutual aid doomsday cult? (Pulitzer Prize, Drama Desk and Outer Critics Awards among others).


# \*\*The Search for Signs of Intelligent Life in the Universe\*\* / performed by Kudra Owens

The play explores the human condition and modern society through the eyes of Trudy, an exceptional homeless woman who claims to be in contact with aliens. Trudy acts as a guide, introducing the audience to various characters whose lives intertwine, each offering a unique perspective on the absurdities and struggles of life and the search for meaning in an often chaotic world. 


